



At-Risk & Title I Assessment For Web Applications

Overview

CMT's **At-Risk & Title I Assessment for Web Applications** software allows users to confirm a student's At-Risk and/or Title I status and report Instructional and Support Services utilized on-line through a user ID and password-protected website. Real-time student information from CIMS is accessed in a point-and-click setting. This custom program is beneficial for districts that are moving towards a paperless environment.

Advantages of CMT's At-Risk & Title I Web Assessment:

- ◆ Reduces At-Risk and Title I processing time and increases accuracy in reporting.
- ◆ Real-time qualifying information from pre-defined assessment data fields default seamlessly into CIMS student database files.
- ◆ Secure, user ID and password-protected environment.
- ◆ Eliminates the shuffling of paper or computer files.
- ◆ Sensitive student data is not stored locally on the PC, increasing security.
- ◆ Run directly from the iSeries through a web browser and does not need to be loaded on each workstation.

The Basics

There are two options available for the At-Risk & Title I Assessment for Web Applications software: **At-Risk & Title I Web Assessment for Teachers** and **At-Risk & Title I Web Assessment for Administrators**. Command buttons provide navigation between screens. The software includes point-and-click web-based environment functionality of: command buttons, mouse-over informational text, drop-down selection boxes, and scroll bars.

Interactive green-screen maintenance programs are included to maintain assessment questions and CIMS student attributes/values associated with these questions. These programs also allow the district to specify the number of qualifications a student must meet in order to receive services. You may also identify which services are offered in each building of the district.

At-Risk & Title I Web Assessment for Teachers: Teachers sign on by entering their iSeries user ID and password. They are presented with an interactive listing of current courses taught by ID, Title, Section, Period, and Days met.

At-Risk & Title I Web Assessment for Administrators: Administrators or Counselors sign on by entering their iSeries user ID and password. Sort options include Counselor ID and Name, Student Name, Student ID, Class and Name, and Class and ID. The Search feature allows the user to find an individual within the listing.
